Orabi's revolution is considered as the first Egyptian revolution in modern history. It was lead by an honest Egyptian leader named Ahmad Orabi and supported by men from the Egyptian army, though they possessed old unsophisticated weapons, but they enjoyed a pure faith in the Egyptian people and their rights to live in freedom, justice and equity in an independent state.

There are numerous studies in evaluation of the Revolution in Egypt and initiator Ahmad Orabi. Historian and researchers of different slants wrote about it.
