three head stone from Fayoum

This paper deals with unpublished three limestone heads, two were found in the corridors of Dionysias temple in Fayoum province, the third one was found also in Fayoum. The three heads preserved in the museum in .Fayoum

The first two of them seem to be head of unknown Egyptian king according to the nemes he wear, analyzing and the comparative study confirm that the head belong to Ptolemaic king , specifically to Ptolemy .VI

The third one is a shaved head, show realistic serious features, after the analysis and comparison it is clear that portrait for a priest of the .Egyptian cult
