The Capitol Influences in the Local Temple in North Africa in the Imperial era

Religious architecture in North Africa influenced by the roman architecture especially in some local temples, which became similar to roman capitol, with its high podium, porch, pronaos, and naos divided to three rooms, such as Saturn temple in Dogga in Tunisia. It is clear that the architect added some of the local elements to this temples so it become very hard call it capitol temples especially this temple were dedicate to local gods.
