

Sultan Ali Dinar's Palace in Al Fasher, An Architectural Archaeological Study.

Abstract:

Sultan Ali Dinar Palace is considered a relic of great civil and architectural value. his Founder is also one of the most famous sultans who ruled the Darfur region. The Sultan built it at the highest peak of the hills surrounding the city of “Al Fasher”. The palace consists of a group of establishments that varied between administrative, residential and service. This research paper aims to study the components of the palace through the descriptive historical method, which deals with the architectural description of the facilities followed by an analytical study of its structural and architectural elements, which is a reflection of the environment of the place and the groups of craftsmen based on its architecture. The study concluded that the Sultan Ali Dinar Palace combined the prevailing architectural modernity of the time with the inherited local traditions.
