ABSTRACT

The Sultan Ali Dinar Museum in Al Fasher contains a large number of Ali Dinar artifacts, including conventional weapons. This paper aims to study a group of swords, daggers and axes through two method : the first is a theoretical and descriptive study that deals with the identification of the owner of those weapons, the place of their preservation, the place of those types of weapons in the Islamic cultural heritage, and a description of the study sample. Second: The archaeological analytical study. These artifacts were linked to political, religious, and economic connotations, the most important of which was the control of the ruler of Sudan over the weapons that Sultan Ali Dinar obtained.
