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This Thesis discusses about Aby Hywa, phonetics , morphology and grammar. It consists of an introduction , three chapters and a conclusion. The introduction given a brief definition of the thesis subject, the study aims and limitations and the studies preceding this subject together with the study course.

The introduction deals with Aby Haywa, his family, teachers and reading, what is meant by peculiar reading, what is meant by the term consistency in Arabic , the importance of language study of the peculiar readings, the relation between Aby Haywa;s readings of the written text of the Holy Books, The reading distinguishing him Aby Haywa and the Hadeith “ Property’s talks” , the recitation sources of Aby Haywa and the phonetic symbols used in the research.

The first chapter : it deals with the phonetic study and consists of nine items ; the hamza as glotal stop or semi - vowel., getting rid of the meeting two consonants, putting a fatha after the consonant, the study of word vocalisation.

The second chapter : it deals with the grammatical study and it is divided into two parts : first is the verbs, it consists of five items; the abstract and the incised, the active and the passive, the vowel of the present simple “ Ain” the forms concerning the male and female, adding pronouns to the verb. The second is the nouns it consists of five items ; the nouns consistency the infinitives, the branches, the internal pleural, the phenomenon of adaptation of foreign words.

The third chapter deals with the grammatical study and consists of four items; the definite and the indefinite, the consistent and the inconsistent.
