Abstract

The phenomenon of transgressing verb of the connected covert pronoun (independent or suffixed) to his connected pronoun is a linguistic pattern the ancient legislators (experts of grammar) Arabic, was observed, who described and analyzed it. Their most important features were identified in grammar, language and interpretation books by me. But this phenomenon has developed since the first moment, and it was rumored in the poetry of the Emroa al-Qays contrary to the rule,: with the actions of the hearts, as stated in the Nobel Qur'an, and the Hadith were contrary to which stabilized among the grammarians, and then cohabitation of the two uses, it resulted the two sides of the phenomenon. But this development was accepted with the appreciation and interpretation, and it was put in the rest of the assumption. It was enough to say that the two things are permissible, without searching for an interpretation of this pattern with non-verbs of the hearts

My plan in this research is summarizing in dividing of the scientific subject to two sections, they are preceded by an introduction I –briefly discussed the issue of the development (evolution) and eternal absence of some the rules. The first section is devoted to talking about truth of the phenomenon and its provisions, and it includes two requirements: one is: the phenomenon in the full or influential verbs, and the other: the phenomenon in the verbs of hearts.

In the second section , we discussed the interpretation and evaluation of four issues, which were dealt with through four demands, one of which is turn away from the rule in the usage, and the second is : the phenomenon between the description and interpretation; and third: escape from forbidden to commit another forbidden.
