Whether he explicitly stated the word weighting or not, he only mentioned its indications in a footnote on Ibn Al-Nazim's explanation of the millennium, which was labeled with "Sunni pearls," and as a result, this study of the Sheikh's opinions reveals a significant aspect of the great scientist among Arabic scholars and one of its imams.
