A Proposed Program in Medical Geography Using the Web Quest for Raising the Faculty of Education Geography Section Students' Awareness of the Issue of Sustainable Development and Some Life Skills

Abstract:

The aim of this research was to investigate the effect of a proposed program in the medical geography using the web quest on raising geography section students' awareness of the issue of sustainable development and some life skills. The sample consisted of (22) fourth year geography section students. A list of the sustainable development awareness issues and a list of some life skills were prepared. The proposed program was developed in medical geography using the web Quest. The measurement tools were applied prior and after the implementation of the program. Results showed that there is a statistically significant difference between the means of ranks of scores of the experimental group in the pre and post administration of the sustainable development awareness issues test and the life skills test, in favor of the post application, at the level of (0.01). The research recommended that the medical geography course should be included in geography programs at the Faculty of Education, and that the issues of sustainable development should be included in different in various geography courses.
