

Title: The Causal Model of the Relationship between the Big Five Personality Factors, Cyber-bullying, and Social Dominance Orientation among University Students.

Abstract:

This study aimed to find the causal model of the relationship between the big five factors of personality, cyber-bullying and the social dominance orientation among university students. The study was conducted on a sample of 398 students at Fayoum University Colleges. The study tools included: the list of the big five factors of personality (prepared by: Costa and Macri, 1985 translated by: Badr Mohammed al-Ansari, 2002), the cyber-bullying scale (prepared by researchers), and social dominance orientation scale (prepared by researchers). The study found a set of findings, the most important of which were: there is a relationship between the big five factors of personality and cyber-bullying, there is a relationship between the big five factors of personality and social dominance orientation, there is a relationship between social dominance orientation and cyber-bullying. There are differences in the study variables were found due to the sex in favour of males. The results also showed a predictive ability of both big five factors of personality and cyber-bullying with social dominance orientation; The results of the study also showed that the constructivist model had quality indicators of good conformity.
