L-band Horn Antenna Radiation Enhancement for GPR Applications by Loading a Wire Medium

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ABSTRACT An L-band horn antenna with modified radiation pattern is customized for ground penetrating radar (GPR) applications. The conventional horn antenna is loaded by a metallic wire medium to enhance the antenna radiation pattern, directivity and gain with reduction of the side-lobes level. These properties are strongly desirable for GPR applications.
