The effectiveness of a professional intervention program in the general practice of social work to develop mothers' awareness of the requirements of social protection for children from trafficking

The issue of human trafficking represents a grave violation of human rights and dignity, and many describe it as the contemporary form of the issue of slavery, where hundreds of thousands of women, children and men are subjected annually to worldwide trafficking for the purpose of exploitation.

Objectives of the study:

- 1- Measuring the return of professional intervention in the general practice of social work in developing mothers' awareness of the requirements of social protection for children from trafficking.
- 2- Reaching a codified program of professional intervention for the general practice of social work to develop mothers' awareness of the requirements of social protection for children from trafficking after designing, experimenting and modifying the intervention program according to the results of the study and the process of quantitative and qualitative analysis of the data.

Study questions:

From this main question, the following sub-questions are derived:
