

The effectiveness of NGOs services in achieving economic security for the disabled from the point of view of social work

Abstract

All societies strive to achieve human security because of its importance in achieving public security, as the safe and reassuring life of the individual and society is not complete without achieving economic security, The positive participation of NGOs in programs and projects to reduce poverty and improve the quality of life for the most vulnerable groups is one of the pivotal goals that NGOs seek to achieve. Among these groups, the most favored groups are the disabled through contributing to achieving human security in general and economic security in particular as one of the dimensions of human security.
