The role of civil society organizations in achieving social protection for the disabled

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Study summary

First: the study problem

Social protection has become one of the programs that take the forefront of the handicapped in the developed and developing world with the aim of conscious planning to effect the intended change to find compatibility between human performance and social functions and the environment in which he lives, and civil society organizations can play an active role in achieving social protection for the disabled.

Second: The objectives of the study:

The study sought to achieve a main objective: to know the role that civil society organizations can play in achieving social protection for the disabled, along with a proposed vision for developing the performance of civil society organizations in achieving social protection for the disabled.

Third: methodological procedures for the study:

- 1- Type of study: This study is considered descriptive and analytical studies
- 2- Study methodology: The researcher used a comprehensive social survey methodology for the disabled benefiting from the services of civil society organizations
- 3- Tools of the study: The researcher used a questionnaire that was applied to an intentionally sample of the disabled who benefit from the services of civil society organizations.

- (A) The spatial domain: the study was applied to a number of civil society organizations serving the handicapped in Fayoum Governorate.
- (B) The human field: The study relied on a comprehensive survey of the disabled who benefited from the services of previous civil society organizations in Fayoum city, with strength of (245) disabled people.
- (C) Time domain: period from 7/5/2017 to 23/8/2017.

Fourth: Results of the study:

Introducing legal legislations that support the social protection of the handicapped, strengthening the partnership between civil society organizations, government agencies and the private sector, raising media attention to the needs of the disabled, directing attention to research and scientific studies that are concerned with the demands and needs of the disabled, and providing social protection for them
