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Despite the advantages, powers, and developments that have occurred in the field of work of NGOs, the professional practice of most of these societies is still going according to the old traditional concepts, methods, models and approaches, which have become in most of them methods that are not appropriate to the nature of the fields, issues and problems that these organizations or even Due to the nature of the contemporary social, economic and political conditions and changes that resulted in these issues and problems, which calls for the need to work on developing the working methods of these associations, and adopting all that is new and appropriate that would activate the NGOs and improve their programs, services and various development projects.

Community dialogue is one of the important approaches that have the benefit of strengthening popular participation in community activities and developing the capabilities of community members to participate in development.

Community dialogue is a developmental approach that helps people understand their societies in a procedural manner that relies on self-learning and consultation by inviting various parties from the community to direct dialogue on priority issues for them. These priorities are arranged and various decisions are reached by the community. This helps to develop the skills of individuals and community institutions, which leads to the formation of continuous communication mechanisms that ensure effective participation of various parties in the decision-making process on an ongoing basis.

The researcher's thought turned to trying to identify the effects of using community dialogue in activating the role of NGOs in the local community to monitor and assess community needs. their needs and identify their priorities by reviewing the descriptive reports that confirm this through the Misr El Kheir Foundation.

Also, some associations that did not receive training on the use of community dialogue were identified, because the researcher made a comparison between those NGOs that were trained to use community dialogue to activate their role, and the NGOs that did not receive a training program on the use of community dialogue.
