Summary

The current study aims to define the requirements of sustainable urban planning for the development of underdeveloped urban areas by identifying the most important social, economic and environmental requirements for sustainable urban planning for the development of underdeveloped urban areas and identify the most important proposals that contribute to the activation of sustainable urban planning in underdeveloped urban areas

The study stressed that the most important social requirements for sustainable urban planning include working to take advantage of human resources in planning decision-making operations, and work to bridge the shortage of social services in underdeveloped urban areas, and work to support social participation of popular leaders in planning processes and stages. The study also emphasized that The most important economic requirements for sustainable urban planning include working to reduce the unemployment rate among youth in underdeveloped areas, and to provide alternative places for workshop owners and factories outside the underdeveloped urban areas, as the study
