Title: The effectiveness of the Bachelor of Social Work program at Fayoum University in light of achieving quality and academic accreditation as a mechanism for developing social work education in Egypt

This study is one of the evaluation studies; As it aimed at evaluating the effectiveness of the Bachelor of Social Work program at Fayoum University, in light of achieving quality and academic accreditation, from the viewpoint of the fourth year students (regularity - affiliation) at the bachelor's stage in social work, as well as faculty members who teach in the Bachelor of Social Work program at Fayoum University The study relied on the social survey method, where the comprehensive social survey of faculty members who are already teaching in the Bachelor of Social Work program at Fayoum University, as well as the comprehensive social survey of fourth year students, The results of the study showed that the level of availability of quality standards and academic accreditation in the specifications of the study program for the Bachelor of Social Work, in the applicable educational regulations and systems, in the material and human resources and capabilities, in the methods of student assessment, and in the contributions of the Bachelor's program in community service is less than the average from two points of view. Students and faculty members, while the level of availability of quality standards and academic accreditation in teaching and learning methods and modern technologies is average for students and less than average from the point of view of faculty members.
