The study is also concerned with Determining the obstacles facing the project to protect women against violence in achieving its objectives, as well as arriving at suggested mechanisms to support the contributions of the project to protect women against violence in achieving its objectives. Experts from the Women's Protection Project, the Social Solidarity Directorate and the National Council for Women As well as field coexistence and the use of observation of the abused women's hosting center, as well as unregulated interviews with battered women and their families, workers in the hosting center and workers responsible for the centers in the Directorate of Social Solidarity, and one of the most important results of the study; That the center needs financial support to play its role towards the affected women, and that there is a need to provide housing for battered women, and it is important to pay attention to conducting field research to identify the needs of women who frequent the center, and the need to allocate a financial resource to provide treatment for the affected women.
