## **Abstracts Research**

Voluntary organizations play an important role in various contemporary humanitarian societies, through their health, education and social welfare assistance, and there are many groups (e.g., the poor, the disabled, the elderly, orphans, street children and women breadwinners), depending on the efforts and contributions of these associations. Where there was a need for cooperation between the national and government sectors, Considering that ngos have an active and important role in addressing many humanitarian problems, as well as their ability to meet the needs of individuals and communities. If Egyptian women suffer from many problems and are exposed to many risks and pressures, poor women are the groups most affected by poverty, marginalization, exclusion and deprivation in all its forms and forms, hence the current study entitled: The role of voluntary organizations in provide in humanitarian care services to poor women who are socially

excluded .The current study aimed to identify voluntary organizations in providing humanitarian care services to poor women who are socially excluded from economic, social, health and educational (awareness), while identifying the obstacles that limit the achievement of these organizations for this role, and finding a set of proposals to activate the role of voluntary organizations in achieving the humanitarian care of poor women who are socially excluded. The study found a set of basic results worthy of consideration where the results of the research showed that voluntary organizations play a role in the provision of humanitarian economic care services, This role was represented in: paying the tuition fees for the children of poor women, and the work of strengthening classes for the children

attached to the schools. These organizations also want a clear role in providing educational humanitarian care services, which is the association's cooperation with the General Authority for Literacy and Adult Education, and contribute to the inclusion of literacy recipients with basic education. And that there are a number of obstacles that stand in the way of these organizations such as poor material funding for the association, difficulty in obtaining foreign financial support, lack of material resources to accomplish some of the

required activities, and the feeling of women that participation in these programs is a waste of time
