Abstract:

That the process of building the capacity of the poor must be a precedent for all development processes, so should it be considered for the poor because they have the capacity to look for distance from the stigmatization of being suffer from the lack or weakness in their abilities, which is standing on the availability of the capacity of the poor the starting point is not in the success of development programs and projects, but also capacity-building programs that drew upon international organizations and local communities.

Therefore, the study responded to a question posed: Is available capacity of the poor can be relied upon in the preparation and implementation of programs and development projects that improve living conditions and thereby contribute to the development of their communities? And through the identification of core capabilities and professional development to enable them to overcome poverty. The study used the pattern of descriptive studies based on social survey method of simple random sample of (81) Single of the poor beneficiaries of the services and assistance to pension security social unity Bandar fourth of the South District of Fayoum.

The study reached the following results:

- 1 - There is the poor basic ability at intermediate level, I got seven indicators at the level of average is, respectively, "index will index, self-confidence, a pointer to their ability to cope with shocks or adapt to them, and then the

movement and dynamism, and management of air conditioning, and their ability to self-improving capabilities, and finally a sense of value index, while obtaining indications of the low level index and the integration and social cohesion index and the exercise of influence reform.

2 - With regard to the professional capacity, nearly two-thirds of the sample to have a craft that can help them cope with the difficulties of life, and the most important letter he speaks poor was carpentry work and domestic service sector and construction.

3 - With regard to capacity development available to the poor or the proposed development, the findings suggest that the poor are willing to participate in the development of society, and they would like training on capacity development in the following order "to take rational decisions , solve problems , respect the views of others, , community participation and investment of resources .
