The level of governance practice and planning indicators to improve the performance of NGOs

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Civil societies are one of the civil society organizations, and one of the most important institutions for the professional practice of social service in general, and the method of organizing society in particular. What increases the importance of civil organizations as a major field of professional practice for the method of organizing society as one of the basic methods for the profession of social service, is the characteristics and powers that these organizations have become distinguished in the present time, which they did not possess in the past, the most important of which are freedom of movement, dealing, flexibility, and the ability to work quickly Which gave it a more official character than before, and this is supported by the number of amendments and changes to Law No. (32) of (1964) related to civil associations and institutions, and the issuance of Law No. (153) of (1999) instead of it, which was also amended by law No. (84) for the year (2002) to give more freedom in working with these organizations.

This is in addition to the expansion of the circle of social and societal fields, issues and problems that civil organizations have come to deal with. These organizations are no longer limited in their work to their traditional fields, activities, issues and problems that have been associated with them since their inception. Civil organizations have achieved a great leap in their size and quality of their activities and fields over the years. The past ten years of the twenty-first century, and in a way through which it can be said that civil organizations have become active and work in almost all social, economic, health and care fields of society, although this activity varies in degree from one field to another.

Despite the advantages, powers and previous developments that occurred in the field of work of civil organizations, the work and practice of the majority of these organizations is still proceeding according to the old traditional concepts, methods, models and approaches, most of which have become inappropriate methods for the nature of the fields, issues and problems that these organizations are now dealing with or even Due to the nature of contemporary social, economic and political conditions and variables that have produced these issues and problems, which necessitates the necessity and importance of working on developing professional practice and work methods used in civil labor institutions in general, and civil associations in particular, as one of the most important institutions for the professional practice of social service, especially the way society is organized. In line with the current social, economic and political developments and changes, as well as in line with the nature of the social and societal problems and issues that these institutions are dealing with, and taking into account all that is new and appropriate and that would activate civil organizations and improve their programs, services and various development projects.
