Abstract:

The current study belongs to the type of descriptive studies. It aims to analyze social Welfare policies for the elderly in Egypt during the time period from (2015-2023) in light of Egypt's Vision 2030, This is done by identifying issues of concern to social Welfare policies for the elderly in Egypt, Objectives, values, procedures, targets, and implementation returns, identifying programs, services, or applied aspects of social Welfare policies for the elderly in Egypt, the results of their implementation, and their impact on the elderly. Determine the expected interactions between social Welfare policies for the elderly and the surrounding forces influencing the making and implementation of those policies, Identifying the obstacles that faced social Welfare policies provided to the elderly, and coming up with proposals to activate social Welfare policies for the elderly in Egypt, To achieve the objectives of the study, the researcher relied on content analysis in collecting data for his study. As a main tool, the researcher prepared it by reviewing David Gill's model in analyzing social welfare policies. The analysis dealt with the articles of the constitution, documents, texts, laws, legislation, decisions, ministerial regulations, documents, programmes, services, projects, protocols, economic, social and political conditions and the extent of their effects, The tool contains a set of components that achieve the objectives of the study, which are defining the problem - defining the research community - defining the unit of analysis - defining the categories of analysis determining the time period for the analysis, The study reached several results: the most important issues were comprehensive coverage of the elderly, and the most important goals were strengthening the role of civil society. The most important values were social welfare and the state's responsibility for caring for the elderly, and that the most important measures are the enactment of legal texts for the welfare of the elderly, and that the most important target groups are the elderly in need of welfare, and that the most important influential forces are government institutions, The most important obstacles were the failure of current policies to meet the needs of the elderly, and the most important proposals were the issuance of special legislation to care for the elderly.
