

Environmental behavior of university youth
" Field study applied to students of Kafr El - Sheikh University"

Abstract

The importance of the current study issue in the study of the environmental behavior of university youth in its various dimensions of knowledge, trends and environmental practices and the impact of socio-economic and demographic variables in the direction of environmental behavior.

In the context of the above, the study aimed at identifying the level of the attitudes of the youth of Kafr El-Sheikh University towards the environment and its various issues

To investigate these objectives, the study used the analytical descriptive approach, which is appropriate to the nature of the study problem, to be based on descriptive method, in which it is possible to analyze the phenomenon of environmental awareness of youth and monitor the relationship between the variables affecting it. As well as the possibility of formulating and testing scientific hypotheses. Using research tools between the questionnaire and then the individual and group interview, and the use of SPSS program, the sample of the study included about 500 students from different faculties of the university

Some of the results of the study showed that about 45.5% of the total respondents have environmental trends. Some 33.3% of respondents have negative environmental trends, while 21.1% of respondents have positive environmental trends. Moreover, the majority of university youth have never participated in environmental conservation activities, accounting for about 59.3% of the total sample, while about 40.7% of the total respondents have participated in carrying out activities to preserve the environment
