Abstract:

The study attempts to provide an understanding of the level of consensus between the various party leaderships and the organizational methods adopted by the party's elite to institutionalize and modernize its mechanisms and the extent or chances of successful completion of the development process in light of the visions, personal attitudes and traditional culture of its local and national leaders. In the context of what is happening in the party as a political institution aimed at change and the formation of the parties to party work

The study chose to delve deeply into the details of the internal interactions of the political activists of the party and the level of their performance of their roles in the positions they occupy in the context of their personal views and attitudes that define their behavior in the face of political events and attitudes and on the other hand modernization procedures. The study attributed importance to the individual actor as a basic analysis unit and understanding his ability to influence decisionmaking in party affairs, while not neglecting the value of institutional .political work as a criterion for development and modernization The study was used the descriptive analytical method, which is suitable for the issues raised by the subject of the study. Using several research tools, such as a questionnaires questionnaire, as well as individual and .group interviews

Some of important results came out of them revealing the support of

the party leaders for the application of these methods, where 75.8% compared to 0.8% of the leaders sample study does not see benefit from the introduction or application, although there is a low percentage do not

want, Of those who consider it to be somewhat useful, or who has a reservation that has reached 23.4%, which is still high, especially since these methods have been implemented by the party for more than seven years
