The review presented a discussion of theoretical conditions and propsal of the study . Moreover , it gives a historical inttroduction about the progress of new reclaimed areas and the initiation of youth graduates villages in Egypt .In addition it includes the characters and different problems of the societies in these new reclaimed areas .

The 2  $\underline{nd}$  chapter "Field work study 'included the scientifc methodology and the societies of study . the work was run to inveestigate , the characters of villages of youth graduates which focused on its geographical and popularity situation , investigation of individual , the problems of environmental conitions and the mechanism of adaptation .

Moreover ,the social and economical situation of youthgraduates in the new villages was evaluated .Theresults were statistically analysed and tabulated . discussion of the presentTheresults was done as well as the conclusions and recommendations of thepresentpresentprojectwerenoted.

the present results revealed three types of beneficiaries which are : 1-adapted beneficiaries . 2- absent beneficiaries which can be divided into two conditions : a) beneficiaries did not live in the village and manipulate their lands through regular and consequently visits . b) Absent beneficiaries did not live in the village and did not manipulat their lands by themselves but leave it to another beneficiaries by seasonal cost, however, the new beneficiaries were not involved in the project as they are not graduated and out of the age of youth . the present investigation revealed physical , social and economic problems which were manipulated by beneficiaries with different methods the study postulated that culture play an important

role in the adaptation of the beneficiaries for the new society, however, new conditions of work and systems of work managementwere elveated. the study cleared an important role for womaen in successful societies in the new reclaimed areas. the results of this investigation increased the chances of work, the distance of cultivated land and imporved the quantity and quality of agricultural crops. large members of Fayomi were migration involved in this project which was reflected on internal and external. The results of

individual conditions revealed consequent improvement in land crops which will reflect on the economic stiuation of graduated youth the social evaluation of studied society

cleared the presence of self-dependence and social values in the form of productive work, initiation of proper reltions and socio-economic p0sitions as well as initiation of hygienic environment.
