There is evidence and documentation confirming this, but through the study of the researcher in the field of art history and its hopes in the Egyptian folk life with its treasures and riches the spirit of Egyptian identity from other identities. The researcher have noticed that the art of pilgrimage mural (the art of popular Egyptian expression of the holy journey) to the specter of extinction in light of the scarcity of scientific research that records and chronicles this wonderful and distinctive folklore and hence can identify the problem of research in the following questions:

- •What are the expressive dimensions and symbolic indications of the plastic vocabulary of the Hajj?

What are the social and religious implications of Hajj?

•How can you record and record the art of pilgrimage murals to face the specter of extinction?

Research Objectives

- •Raise awareness and draw attention to the danger facing the murals of the pilgrimage as a vessel to resist elimination.
