ABSTRACT

Pediatric general surgical emergencies may present to the pediatric surgeon with a diagnostic challenge. Children and especially neonates present with modified clinical manifestations, which may lead to errors and delays in diagnosis, with frequent delays in management. Proper care and early diagnosis and therefore early management will minimize miss diagnoses and resultant complication.

The study was carried out on 710 cases admitted to pediatric emergency department during the year 2000. All possible data about these cases will be collected.
