Post-TURP endorectal balloon inflation is a simple, safe, and efficient procedure for patients with small prostate and does not need special operative technique. It seems to reduce the postoperative blood loss, frequency of blood transfusion, postoperative irrigation, and shortens the catheterization time and length of hospital stay. However, this technique is still not universally accepted as the standard of care for a majority of such patients around the world.
