Tunis Village in Fayoum: Opportunities and Challenges of Tourism investment Mohamed N. El-Barbary

Abstract

Tourism is growing rapidly all over the world, by the virtue of tourist motivations' variety and Tunis village in Fayoum -which is located on the Coast of Qarun Lake, about 130 K.M to the south of Cairo- is a unique touristic site with multiple features and famous for its simplicity, calmness, beautiful landscapes and the high quality of its local products, especially the pottery.
